## Third Sunday of Lent

God said to Moses of Himself: I AM WHO I AM -

Any time I hear the story of Moses' encounter with God I think of Holy Ground and the song that goes with it.

To encounter the sacred for Moses was astonishing.

It wasn't just the fire, the burning bush, but God proximate to the creature. A revelation beginning at the time of Moses that developed to its fullness in the person of Christ.

By the time you have read this we will have completed our Lenten Retreat. On the first night we heard the nature of the personal call of each of us to "know" Jesus. Not just information but knowing within the burning heart of every one of us.

As we follow Christ in our modern world amidst so many lights we call on the incarnate and proximate God to extend His gifts of Grace to us so that we might understand the Holy Ground of encounter that is in His word, prayer, the sacraments, fellow brothers and sisters.

The other side of the encounter of God's call is that it tends to eliminate fear and to communicate on common ground. Perhaps you can notice for yourself the call of God to holiness as a call to ourselves into His holiness.

To be Holy is about wholeness, oneness, communion, likeness to the Creator. The God who pursues us does so at times almost relentlessly.

It is always God who is offering us opportunities to respond to His unconditional divine love.

The year of Faith perhaps is creating opportunities to notice the Faith of people like Moses, St Patrick whose feast we will celebrate shortly, the faith of the neighbour tending to a person in need or simply being present in love, kindness, tolerance, peace to others.

Our present season of Lent is also known as the Season of Grace.

In faith you might pray for the graces you need – big or small – ordinary and some extraordinary.

Perhaps there are areas in life where we simply need to let go of the obstacles between God and ourselves or between another and ourselves to let God touch our life situations and circumstances.

It isn't necessarily our own effort but God's Grace and Love that will change us, move us, to His Will. On our part we need to recognise those things that stunt our response and our relationship with God or our neighbour. Now is as good as any time to cooperate with the Lord.
